The Master Teacher of Entrepreneurship (MTEnt) program is designed for middle and high school teachers to increase their understanding of entrepreneurship. The program improves teachers' abilities to actively engage their students through stand-alone entrepreneurship courses or to integrate this subject area as a strand within other business curricula. MTEnt trainings are offered as a collaborative initiative between the Center for Economic and Entrepreneurship Education at the University of Southern Mississippi (CEEE), the Mississippi Council on Economic Education, and the Mississippi Department of Education. The Department of Education confers the "Master Teacher of Entrepreneurship" designation. (Please note that this is a State certificate program and not a degree.) Eligible teachers may apply for the 915 Entrepreneurship Endorsement upon successful completion of the program.

MCEE invests \$1,750 of funding on each teacher that we accept into the program to include the cost of instruction, materials and CEUs. **There is no cost to the teacher, school or district for this program.** Teachers who successfully complete the program will receive a \$250 stipend.
