



Incentives for Fall 2023/Spring 2024 Trading Sessions

School (guaranteed for Fall 2023 and Spring 2024 trading sessions)– Teams play at no cost to the school or teacher (the MS Council on Economic Education will pay team fees on behalf of teacher)

Teacher (guaranteed for the Fall 2023 trading session only, so play in the fall if you can, spring incentives will be paid based on the availability of funds) – The MS Council on Economic Education will pay a \$20 stipend* (to the teacher) for each team of 3-5 students in their classroom that actively participates in the Stock Market Game and makes at least 3 trades by December 1, 2023. This incentive will not exceed \$500 per teacher. Teachers will be required to complete a participation survey sharing the demographics of students that played by the deadline of Friday, December 15, 2023 to receive the stipend. Spring deadlines will be announced later if funding allows for these stipends in the spring semester.



One teacher each month will be selected at random to receive a box of classroom supplies.
Teams must be actively trading to be eligible.



Students (guaranteed for the Fall 2023 and Spring 2024 trading session) -

At the ceremony students will hear from a motivational speaker and receive prizes. Teachers and parents will be invited to attend with the students.
